OVERVIEW:

The Crisis Prevention Institute (CPI) developed the Nonviolent Crisis Intervention Training (NVCI) in the late 1960's. It is a highly recommended and well-recognized national and international workshop that teaches basic proven crisis intervention techniques to defuse disruptive and assaultive behavior. It is often a mandatory requirement for health care organizations.

WHAT YOU WILL LEARN:

- How to identify behaviors that could lead to a crisis.
- How to respond to prevent the situation from escalating
- How to use verbal and nonverbal techniques to resolve a crisis before it becomes violent
- How to use principles of personal safety to avoid injury if behavior becomes physical
- How to develop team intervention strategies and techniques
- How to maintain rapport with the acting-out individual
- Key steps for debriefing after a crisis
